

BPHS Graduation Requirements and Guidelines 23/24

220 (minimum) Credits Required to Graduate

Language Arts – 40 Credits

- Required: Advanced Language Arts – 10 Credits (2 classes)

Social Studies – 30 Credits

- Required: Civics or US Government – 2.5 Credits

Mathematics – 22.5 Credits

- Required: 10 Credits Beyond Algebra I
- Required: 2.5 Credits Math Capstone (Choose 1 of the following)
 - Financial Literacy
 - Data Science
 - Math for Life

Science – 25 Credits

- Required: Computer Science – 2.5 Credits
- Required: Environmental Science – 2.5 Credits

Physical Education/Health – 10 Credits

- Required: Health – 2.5 Credits
- Required: Physical Education – 2.5 Credits

Fine Arts & Humanities – 20 Credits

World Languages – 10 Credits

Service Learning – 10 Credits - Any combination of the following:

- Service Learning Class (Required) = 2.5 credits
- Volunteer (25 hours using log sheet + 1 Page Reflection, approved by advisor) = 2.5 credits
- Internship (50 hours using log sheet + 1 Page Paper, approved by advisor) = 2.5 credits
- Paid Work (100 hours + 1 Page Paper, submit paystubs) = 2.5 credits
